



Welcome to our twenty-fifty prophecy update and I don't know if you are seeing this, but I see things spiraling faster and faster toward the start of the Day of Jacob's Trouble or what we know it as, *THE SEVEN YEAR TRIBULATION PERIOD!* 

Now please understand that I did not say that things are spinning out of control, like some would say and believe. Even some Christians feel this way as we see the downward trend away from morality and into immorality!



But they are not spinning out of control, they are happening just as the Lord has told us and warned us!



I think far too often we hear prophecy teachers speaking of the gloom and doom of what is happening and what is ahead, but they miss the point. And before we even begin to look at what is going on in the world, I want you to understand that our hope is *NEVER* in this world, but our hope must always be in the *LORD*!

Let me ask you this question. Why has the Lord told us what is going to happen before it happens?

There are several things we can say regarding this. But let me just share with you what the Lord has to say in Isaiah 44:6-8. We are told, "<u>Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel,</u> <u>And his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is</u> <u>no God. And who can proclaim as I do? Then let him declare it and set it in order for Me,</u> <u>Since I appointed the ancient people. And the things that are coming and shall come, Let</u> <u>them show these to them. Do not fear, nor be afraid; Have I not told you from that time,</u> <u>and declared it? You are My witnesses. Is there a God besides Me? Indeed there is no other</u> <u>Rock; I know not one.</u>"

First of all, God uses prophecy or speaking forth the things that will come to pass before they happen to show us that He is God!

In fact, He challenges others to try to do this with 100% accuracy and there are NONE who can do that like the Lord. In fact, just related to the first coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, it is beyond any mathematical probability.

Listen to what I mean. For just 8 of the over 300 prophecies of Jesus related to His first coming to come to pass in any one man, it would be 1 in  $10^{17}$ ! (That would be 1 with 17 zeros after the one)

And for just 48 prophecies to come to pass, it would be 1 in  $10^{157}$ !

Now I know, that is hard to comprehend, so let me help you out on this. We are told,

The electron is about as small an object as we know of. It is so small that it will take 2.5 times  $10^{15}$  of them laid side by side to make a line, single file, one inch long. If we were going to count the electrons in this line one inch long, and counted day and night, it would take us 19,000,000 years to count just the one-inch of these electrons.

If we had a cubic inch of these electrons and we tried to count them it would take us, counting steadily 250 each minute, 19,000,000 times 19,000.000 times 19,000,000 years or 6.9 times  $10^{21}$  years.

With this introduction, let us go back to our chance of 1 in 10<sup>157</sup>. Let us suppose that we are taking this number of electrons, marking one, and thoroughly stirring it into the whole mass, then blindfolding a man and lett5ing him try to find the right one. What chance has he of finding the right one? What kind of pile will this number of electrons make? They make an inconceivably large volume. (Stoner, SS, 109, 110)

Such is the chance of any individual fulfilling forty-eight prophecies.

And please understand that I am not saying God gets it right 99% of the time, but 100% of the time and His prophecies are not vague but very accurate and to the point! There is no one else who can do that, only *GOD*!

So God has told us what is going to happen before it happens showing us that He alone is God and that information that He has given to us is to help us witness of Him!

What do I mean by that?

I mean that knowing what is going to happen before it happens brings comfort to our hearts and our lives knowing that God is in control, He has told us these things.



Not only that, but now that we know what is going to happen, as we see these things take place, we can share it with others, others can see that we are not anxious, worried about what is happening and the reason why is that God has warned us and we are prepared!

I hope you are seeing the importance of knowing what is going to take place before it happens, it prepares us!

In the book of Jeremiah, we see God pronouncing judgment upon the Southern Kingdom of Judah for their idolatry, for their turning away from the Lord.

And in Jeremiah 6:16-17 we are told, "<u>Thus says the Lord: 'Stand in the ways and see,</u> <u>And ask for the old paths, where the good way is, And walk in it; Then you will find rest</u> <u>for your souls. But they said, "We will not walk in it." Also, I set watchmen over you,</u> <u>saying, "Listen to the sound of the trumpet!" But they said, "We will not listen.""</u>"

I believe what Jeremiah was saying to the people living in the Southern Kingdom of Judah, the Lord is speaking to us as a nation and as individuals.

Go back to the old paths, the Word of God, it is good, it is healthy, and thus, if you want rest, then walk in them.

But, the children of Israel living in the Southern Kingdom of Judah said, "<u>We will not</u> <u>listen.</u>" And that is what we are seeing today as we look at the people living in this world, and those in the church, at least some of them, *THEY WILL NOT LISTEN!*  We also see this spoken of in II Chronicles 36:15-16, where we are told, "<u>And the Lord</u> <u>God of their fathers sent warnings to them by His messengers, rising up early and sending</u> <u>them, because He had compassion on His people and on His dwelling place. But they</u> <u>mocked the messengers of God, despised His words, and scoffed at His prophets, until the</u> <u>wrath of the Lord arose against His people, till there was no remedy.</u>"

Today, like back then, there are those who are speaking forth the truths of God found in the Word of God. They are warning people of the dangers that are out there, that they not only need to come to Christ, but also, to those who are saved, warning of the New Age and Eastern Mysticism that is coming into the church, the false doctrine that is flooding into the church.

And what is happening is that those who are standing up for the truths of God found in the Word of God are mocked, they are put down, they are called intolerant and unloving and-soon!

But as people and so-called Christians move farther and farther from God, as they mock the messengers of God, despise the Word of God, there is coming a day, and I believe it is getting closer and closer, were they will pass that point of no return and there will be no remedy for them, God's wrath will be poured out upon them!

I have broken these studies down into several points and they all have to do with the fact that *"THEY WILL NOT LISTEN"* to what God has said and they will, in the end, face the consequences of their actions.

This is how I have broken things down:

*COME OUT FROM AMONG THEM – WE WILL NOT!* (This will deal with the church and how it has become more worldly)

#### I FORMED YOU IN THE WOMB – DON'T TOUCH – WE WILL NOT! (This is

dealing with the sanctity of life and how we don't look at life as being a gift of God)

#### APPLE OF MY EYE - ISRAEL - DON'T TOUCH - WE WILL NOT! (This is looking


at Israel and how the world is becoming more anti-Semitic that will eventually bring us to the war of Ezekiel chapters 38 & 39 with Russia, Iran and Turkey being the key players in this battle)

**FOLLOW ME – WE WILL NOT!** (This will be looking at the world's turning from the Lord and they will embrace a global government. We will also be looking at how people will refuse to follow the Lord and they will embrace technology. And with this technology and the advances that have been made, it will ultimately allow the Antichrist and the false prophet to control all life on this planet)

*SUM IT UP – WE WILL NOT!* (This will focus on what is coming, the judgment of God upon a Christ rejecting world and what our responsibility should be until the church is called home)


With that as our introduction, let's begin by looking at our first point:

### 1. COME OUT FROM AMONG THEM – WE WILL NOT!



Now you can agree with me or not on this one, but I can't believe how far the church is moving away from God and His Word in the days we are living in.

And please understand that I am not saying we should not be in the world sharing our faith but isolate ourselves from unbelievers. No, we are to be in the world, but the world is not to be in us. And yet, that is exactly what we see happening.



Jesus warns us in Matthew chapter 24 that deception would play a big part of the last days scenario and that is what we are seeing today.

And the reason that the deception is growing is because people have itchy ears, they want their ears tickled, they are not interested in the truth and thus, they find teachers who will tell them what they want to hear.



We also see teachers that are more than happy to bring in worldly teaching, worldly philosophy, worldly ideas into the church, and thus, the apostasy that the Bible warns us about is upon us.



Remember what Paul wrote in II Corinthians 6:14-18, "Do not be unequally voked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: 'I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people.' Therefore 'Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the Lord Almighty." Not only what Paul said here in II Corinthians but listen to what James 4:4 tells us,

#### "Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity

# with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God."

## And what Paul wrote in Romans 12:2, "<u>And do not be conformed to this world, but be</u> <u>transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and</u> <u>acceptable and perfect will of God.</u>"

I think this is very clear. We are to come out from the world because the Lord has called us to!

We are not to be friends of the world because as we embrace the world's ways, we become an enemy of God!

And we are not to be conformed to this world, look like them, act like them, talk like them, but we are to be transformed by God as He renews our minds as we are in the Word of God!

But look at what has happened in the church today. We say things like,

"God wants me happy" instead of "God wants me to be obedient and faithful to His Word."

We behave like the world. Christian divorce rates have surpassed the general public! Christians have fallen for the culture's mantra that personal fulfillment is more important than marriage vows.

We have taken the Holy Spirit out of the picture in regard to how the church is to function and we have replaced the Holy Spirit with worldly ideas!

We see that thousands of evangelical churches have adopted the "marketdriven" approach to their cities and try to woo people in as satisfied customers. So preaching about sin, holiness, and divine judgment are avoided as being too confrontational towards society.

And when we look at worship, much that passes for "worship" in contemporary churches would be difficult to distinguish from a secular rock concert!

I think that the late Francis Schaeffer was right when he called this embracing of our culture "the great evangelical disaster" and said further that "the evangelical church has accommodated [itself] to the world."



And make no mistake about it, too many in the American Church are imitating our

culture! Let me show you what I mean with this list and then I will give you some examples we

are seeing today regarding this departure from the faith, from the truths of God found in the

Word of God.

Teaching that the Bible is not inspired and inerrant. Using books instead of the Bible in Bible study. Teaching that there is more than one way to God besides Jesus. Being embarrassed to say that Jesus is the only way to salvation. Teaching that there is no absolute right and wrong. Being careful to not offend anyone at the expense of biblical truth. Pastors preaching moralism instead of Christ centered messages. Approving of homosexuality. Approving of women pastors/elders. Not condemning the sins of society. Psychology as an authority on human nature. Use of politically correct terms of the world from the pulpit where those terms replace biblical values and truths. Going to church as a social habit. Prayer as a last resort. Missionaries not sent out or supported. Divorce statistics as common as secular society. Evolution.

I guess Paul warned us that this will happen in the last days as he wrote in II Timothy 4:1-5, "<u>I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the</u> <u>living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: Preach the word! Be ready in</u> <u>season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.</u> <u>For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their</u> <u>own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and</u> <u>they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. But you be</u> <u>watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your</u> ministry."

And that is exactly where we are at today. Now please understand I am not saying that every church or that we are the only church around that teaches the Word of God, but the numbers are dwindling down because that is not how you *GROW* a church today and that is what leaders and people are interested in doing instead of being obedient to God and His Word!

Let me give you a few examples to show you where we are at today.

The First Annual Christian Witches Convention Will Teach That Jesus Was a Sorcerer Who 'Performed Alchemy' (a power or process that changes or transforms something in a mysterious or impressive way) And the Bible Is Really A 'Book Of Magic'



In an extended discussion with Witcher approximately two months ago on reconciling the practice of witchcraft and Christianity, Witcher, whose website says he "brings God's messages to humanity through powerful teaching and training, allowing non-traditional followers to hear the divine voice of hope," said the Bible is a "huge book of sorcery."

"The Bible is a huge book of sorcery. You literally can't get around that. You can't get around Jesus being a magician. There's just no way," he said. . . .

The Rev. Valerie Love, the force behind the event who describes herself as a practicing Christian witch and an ordained minister of spiritual consciousness, recently launched the Covenant of Christian Witches Mystery School to help Christians tap into magic, which critics are condemning as "dangerous." She insists there is nothing wrong with the idea of Christians practicing magic despite biblical warnings against it. . . .

"You're talking about sorcery at its base understanding, it's really just being able to change the natural by supernatural means. That's really it. It's an alchemical process. It's to say that you turn water into wine. One, two fish and five loaves of bread, feeding the multitude – absolutely forms of sorcery. Walking on water defined the natural realm and laws that govern this physical plane. That's all realms of sorcery. Magic is simply just using the props to do it," he contended.

"You're talking about the whole of Jesus' adult ministry is all magic, all sorcery. Even if we just say 'Jesus.' Every particular miracle Jesus does defies human law, defies the laws of the universe and the world. So . . . you can't really talk about being a Jesus follower without doing what he did which is magic."

So there is nothing wrong with witchcraft, the Bible supports witchcraft?

All I can say is this, "Have you not read . . .?"

Listen to what we are told in Deuteronomy 18:10-12, "<u>There shall not be found among</u> you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, *or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.* For all who do these things are an abomination to the Lord, and because of these abominations the Lord your God drives them out from before you."

Then we have . . .


Through interviewing hundreds of Christians, his research revealed that professing Christian's most important beliefs about their faith are:

- God wants people to be good, nice, and fair to each other

- The central goal of life is to be happy and feel good about one's self

- Good people go to heaven when they die

Smith coined the term Moralistic Therapeutic Deism (MTD) to describe this form of Christianity. It is moralistic, in that there are rules; deistic in that there is a god, and therapeutic because the goal of this faith is happiness.



Just look at the title of Brian Houston's (founder of Hillsong Church) book and you'll see a form of Christianity overly concerned with the one's material condition. Add to that the Hillsong worship experience that is more of a psychological experience than communing with the divine, and you have a faith that makes no sense to questions of morality, holiness, and truth.

As if right on cue, I talked to a high school aged boy this week who grew up in the church. He chuckled as I suggested that God is not primarily concerned with us being happy, as if to say "you're joking, right?"

The Hillsong phenomena may be a very visible and organized form of pop-Christianity, but any time you see a church losing focus on holiness, wisdom, truth, and beauty, and trade it in for entertainment, gimmickry, and focusing on the present world, it is making a mockery of Christianity. Unfortunately, our culture is full of pop-Christianity vying for members and donors instead of disciples.

ROME, November 6, 2019 (LifeSiteNews) – A reconstruction of a pagan idol who demanded child sacrifice was stationed at the entrance of Rome's Colosseum as part of a secular historical exhibition.

The presence of the idol raised particular concern among Catholics, as it was erected nine days before the Amazon Synod and the subsequent scandal over the veneration of the Pachamama idol at the Vatican.

"A reconstruction of the terrible deity Moloch, linked to Phoenician and Carthaginian religions and featured in the 1914 film Cabiria (directed by Giovanni Pastore and written by Gabriele D'Annunzio) will be stationed at the entrance to the Colosseum to welcome visitors to the exhibition," stated a press release about the exhibit.

The statue of Moloch was erected nine days prior to the opening of the Amazon Synod, which was plagued with controversy from the beginning after a ceremony in the Vatican Gardens involving the pagan goddess "Pachamama" was held in the presence of Pope Francis and topranking prelates.

Some Catholics are distressed that the pagan god Moloch has been erected at the entrance to the Colosseum, which is one of many amphitheaters where Christians were tortured and executed for the entertainment of the pagan crowds.

"We were so excited the day we decided to go to the Colosseum," Alexandra Clark told LifeSiteNews via email. She and her sister Tiffany were looking forward to visiting the site of Christian martyrdom.

"But the moment we got there the sight that greeted us was horrifying! Standing guard over the entrance was the colossal pagan statue of Moloch. It was placed in that prime spot so that everyone that entered into the Colosseum had to pass it," she continued.

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"It was like they put Moloch there to mock the sacred place where the holy martyrs spilled their blood for the True Faith!"

Clark saw a connection between the idol of Moloch and the Pachamama images that featured so prominently at the recently concluded Amazonian Synod.

"Both of these evil pagan idols required child sacrifices and both of them came to Rome at about the same time [as] the Synod," she said.

The two sisters remained near the Moloch statue to gauge other reactions. Clark noted that a few others, including religious sisters, were clearly shocked by the giant figure.

The image of Moloch is modeled on a representation of the child-devouring demon found in the 1914 Italian silent film Cabiria. In the film the idol of Moloch, set up in a Punic temple, has a giant bronze furnace in his chest, into which hundreds of children are thrown. Cabiria, the heroine of the film, is threatened with this fiery fate.

The film's depiction of the idol has a historical basis. Three ancient Greek historians all attest that it was customary in Carthage to burn children alive as offerings to the deity, whom they called Baal and Cronus or Saturn, the Roman god who, according to myth, ate his own children lest they supplant him. Moloch is also mentioned several times in the Book of Leviticus. Hebrew parents are forbidden to sacrifice their children to the god.

Why in the world would you put up something like that?

Well, that is not exactly correct. What I should have said is that the Protestant Church has compromised what it believes, what the Bible teaches, to join the Roman Catholic Church.

And we should be aware of this and it should sound very familiar because this is exactly what the Bible says will happen.

There will be a false prophet, a leader and this is what we are told of this man, "<u>Then I</u> saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed." Revelation 13:11-15.

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Notice the two horns, power and he appears to be a lamb. He appears to be a believer! How do I know that he is not a believer?

Again, listen to what we are told in this first verse, Revelation 13:11, how he speaks. We are told that he speaks, "... like a dragon."

It is this false prophet that will get the world to worship the Antichrist and his pseudo resurrection, appearing like Jesus Christ. They will worship the Antichrist as God!



Let me show you what the Roman Catholic Church and the Islamic church did back on February 13, 2019. We are told,

A historic document signed recently by Pope Francis and leading Muslim Imam Sheikh Ahmed al-Tayeb – whose official title is The Grand Imam of Al-Azhar – has many observers very concerned. This historic meeting between the head of the Roman Catholic Church and the most important Imam in Sunni Islam took place in Abu Dhabi at a gathering of religious leaders representing Christianity, Islam, Judaism, and other faiths.

On the surface the covenant entitled "A Document on Human Fraternity for World Peace and Living Together" stipulates its intention is to foster peace between nations, religions, and ethnic groups while combating extremism and violence. Obviously, this is an admirable effort worthy of support. Yet, certain ambiguous language in the document regarding God leads many to be cautious of the implications that may arise. Particularly, the idea that such a document could form the groundwork for a one-world religion!

... The document uses the same term; God, to simultaneously reference the God of the Bible and Allah. One glaring example of this categorizes Christians and Muslims as "We, who believe in God." Perhaps equally problematic is that the document claims that "the pluralism and the diversity of religions" evident in the world were all intentionally "willed by God."

Moreover, the document claims that the idea that people should "adhere to a certain religion" should be rejected. Therefore, according to this document the perfect will of God allows for hundreds of different religions that must all be considered as equally valid.

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Such ideas have caused many to consider that the essence of this document is to push for a one-world religion. Sadly, this idea is not out of character for Pope Francis. In September 2015, during a stop at St. Patrick's Cathedral, Pope Francis stressed the unity between Christianity and Islam. Likewise, in January 2016 the Vatican released an extremely disturbing video in which Pope Francis declared that all of the major world religions are "seeking God or meeting God in different ways."

We are also told,

Over the last twelve months, we have seen major efforts by the Vatican to build a bridge between Catholics and multiple religious leaders around the world. And with great success! It is the continuation of a decades-old attempt to gather all religions into an all-inclusive global religious community, and it is in the last stages of development. The question is not will a oneworld religion be formed, but how close are we to its culmination?

In his book Perestroika, Mikhail Gorbachev said there are three root causes for war political conflicts, religious conflicts and economic conflicts. Moments before meeting with reporters, the entire Protestant delegation, for the first time ever, entered the confessional to take part, individually, in the Sacrament of Penance. "It's important that we participate in these sacred rituals before asking our congregation to do the same," Pastor Osteen said, adding that his time in confession was "an immensely moving experience."

As Protestants around the world make the transition to Catholicism, many are wondering what, exactly, that means for them. "First and foremost we acknowledge the Pope's infallibility with regard to universal moral declarations, the authority of Church magistrate, faith, and ex cathedra," [ex cathedra means, with the full authority of office (especially of the Pope's infallibility as defined in Roman Catholic doctrine)] said Father Cliff Brogan, a former Protestant pastor who was the first of the delegation to be ordained as a priest at the Vatican. "Secondly, we participate in the sacrament of the Eucharist by accepting the actual body and blood of Christ, an event known as Transubstantiation, at the conclusion of the holy mass." As part of their induction into the Catholic faith, all Protestants above the age of fifteen are required to undergo a Catholic Confirmation, one of three sacraments of initiation, out of seven total, which Catholics can receive. "Most, if not all, of us have been baptized," said Father Brogran. *"However, without formal Confirmation, our Protestant baptisms will be null, thus preventing us from entering the Kingdom of Heaven."* 

Additionally, during the transition period, American Protestant families whose children attend Sunday School are to receive vouchers allowing them to participate in CCD programs at area Catholic churches.

In a show of support for the reunification under the Holy See, the United Kingdom announced Wednesday that it is taking steps to reunify Northern Ireland with The Republic of Ireland. The government of the UK has acknowledged the stark differences between the two countries, but according to one official, *"We are, for the first time, one people, united under the Bishop of Rome, acting together as the bride and servant of Christ."*

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Now I am sorry, but I have to correct that because it is wrong and yet you say this loud enough and long enough, like Bernie Sanders does, people will believe it. Sweden, Norway and Denmark are not socialist countries, they are very much pro-capitalism, the very thing that this article is speaking against!

And I can understand the world buying into this, but now we have those in the church who are telling us that Jesus was a socialist and they are opening the door for socialism to be brought into this country and will eventually bring us to the place where we are not a world leader any longer but just part of a One World Government!

Let me just share this with you, and it is obvious, but that does not seem to matter much today, Jesus was not a socialist! But let's answer that question, *"Was Jesus a Socialist?"* 

Well, if socialism is nothing more than being kind to other people, then you might think the answer is yes. But you can be kind to other people and be a capitalist. John D. Rockefeller probably gave away more money than anyone in human history, and he was certainly a capitalist. Bill Gates and Warren Buffet have given away millions, too.

To get an accurate answer to our question, we need to define socialism.

Socialism is the concentration of power into the hands of government elites to achieve the following purposes: central planning of the economy and the radical redistribution of wealth. Jesus never called for any of that. Nowhere in the New Testament does he advocate for the government to punish the rich – or even to use tax money to help the poor. Nor does he promote the ideas of state ownership of businesses or central planning of the economy.

In Luke 12, Jesus is confronted by a man who wants him to redistribute wealth. "Master," the man says to Jesus, "tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." Jesus replies, "Man, who made me a judge or divider over you?" and then he rebukes the man for being envious of his sibling.

How about Jesus's Parable of the Talents (talents were a form of money in Jesus's day)? A man entrusted three of his workers with his wealth. The two who invested the money and made a profit were praised and the one who buried his share so he wouldn't lose any of it was reprimanded. Sounds a lot more like an endorsement for capitalism than socialism, doesn't it?

Yes, Jesus spoke of the difficulty for a rich man to enter Heaven, but not because having money is evil. It's not money; rather, it is the love of money, the New Testament tells us, that leads to evil. Jesus was warning us not to put acquisition of money and material possessions above our spiritual and moral lives.

Was Jesus promoting a socialist model when he kicked the "moneychangers" out of the Temple in Jerusalem? Again, the answer is no. Note the location where the incident occurred: it was in the holiest of places – God's house. Jesus was not angry at buying and selling in and of themselves; he was angry that these things happened in a house of prayer. He never drove a "moneychanger" from a marketplace or from a bank.

Jesus advises us to be of "generous spirit" – to show kindness, to assist the widow and the orphan. But he clearly means this to be our responsibility, not the government's.

Consider Jesus's Good Samaritan story. A traveler comes upon a man at the side of a road. The man had been beaten and robbed and left half-dead. What did the traveler, the Good Samaritan, do? He helps the unfortunate man on the spot, with his own resources.

Ask yourself: To help the poor, would Jesus prefer that you give your money freely to the Salvation Army, for example, or have it taxed by politicians to fund a welfare bureaucracy? Progressives like to point out that Jesus said, "Render unto Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and unto God the things that are God's."

But that has absolutely nothing to do with high taxes or wealth redistribution. It was the seed for the idea of separating church and state. It certainly wasn't the same as saying that whatever Caesar says is his must then be so, no matter how much he demands or what he intends to use it for.

So, there is no evidence that Jesus was a socialist. And there is lots of evidence that he supported free markets.

In addition to the Parable of the Talents, Jesus offers his Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard. In it, a landowner hires some laborers to pick grapes. Near the end of the day, he realizes he needs more workers to get the job done.

To recruit them, he agrees to pay a full day's wage for just one hour of work. When one of the laborers who had worked an entire day complains, the landowner answers, "I am not being unfair to you, friend. Didn't you agree to work for a denarius? Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money?" That's a testament to the principles of supply and demand, of private property, and of voluntary contracts, not socialism.

Jesus never endorsed the forced redistribution of wealth. That idea is rooted in envy, something that he, and the Tenth of the Ten Commandments, railed against. Most importantly, Jesus cared about helping the less fortunate. He never would have approved anything that undermines wealth creation. And the only thing that has ever created wealth and lifted masses of people out of poverty is free market capitalism. Read the New Testament. The plain meaning of the text is loud and clear: Jesus was not a socialist.

He couldn't be. He loved people, not the state.

The other day, I joined clergy from many faiths in a worship service that, like many others, featured poetry, music, ritual and prayer. But this service was different. Its purpose was to bring blessings on a reproductive health clinic that provides abortions.

With their presence as well as their prayers, 10 diverse faith leaders proclaimed what too few people have heard: Religious people can be pro-choice, not in spite of their faith but because of it.

Too few have heard this, in large part because Christian conservatives have been exceptionally loud and strident in condemning abortion as religiously and morally unacceptable. But their religious understanding of abortion is not the only understanding. It never has been.

The blessing of the Whole Woman's Health clinic in Austin on Tuesday (July 9) in cooperation with Texas Freedom Network and the Religious Coalition for Reproductive Choice is one recent example of a long tradition of progressive faith communities supporting women making reproductive decisions according to their own conscience.

Presbyterians, Episcopalians, Unitarian Universalists, United Church of Christ members, Disciples of Christ members and Reform and Reconstructionist Jews are among the people of faith who affirm individuals, free of others' judgment, considering all options for responding to a pregnancy.

While these progressive traditions differ on some matters of belief, they share a core set of values. They believe that each person is created in the divine image with the right and capability to make decisions about their own bodies and their own lives.

Because our prophetic teachings emphasize caring for our neighbors, progressive faith communities are called to respond to pregnant people with compassion and affirmation. We know that making reproductive decisions can be hard work spiritually and emotionally, yet we believe God accepts the decisions of conscience each person makes.

Bestowing blessings on an abortion clinic, however, is more than symbolic. Tuesday's ceremony - and others like it that have been held in Maryland, Ohio and Washington, D.C. - brought solace and encouragement to the clinic's clients and the health care professionals who serve them.

During our ceremony in Austin, I had the honor of sharing journal entries from past clients. As I spoke their words of honesty and wisdom, I was moved to tears by their strength, resolve and deep faith. We recognize that those who receive care at the clinic may struggle with stigma, shame and guilt that originates not necessarily from within themselves, but from messages taught by their families, communities and places of worship.

Some may feel alone. Some may feel conflicted. Some must struggle to gather the funds needed to pay for an abortion or to arrange for the procedure at the right phase of pregnancy. And their arrivals at the clinic often begin with the unnerving experience of passing through a crowd of angry, jeering protesters.

Physicians, nurses and other staff members at abortion clinics are also subject to intense stress from religiously sponsored foes of abortion who accost them, question their morality, vandalize the clinics and threaten the safety of these professionals and their families.

Our calling as progressive faith leaders is to bear witness to the pain caused in the name of faith and to respond with words and actions rooted in love, compassion and understanding. . . .

A physician who joined in a clinic blessing ceremony in Washington, D.C., revealed how the blessing might continue to make an impact in the future. She said that now she would be able to tell clients who may be frightened or emotional, "This is a blessed space." The Whole Woman's Health clinic in Austin is also a blessed space, not only because of our ritual of blessing on Tuesday but because providing reproductive health services has always been sacred work. May progressive people of faith continue to join together in the face of today's stark political and social climate. Together may we create even more spaces that accept and welcome each person's own reproductive decisions.

ICELAND, August 15, 2017 (LifeSiteNews) – A new report from CBS News details how 100 percent of babies in Iceland who are diagnosed with Down syndrome prenatally are aborted.

This has "almost completely eliminated Down syndrome births since the test began in the early 2000s," Elaine Quijano of CBS explained. She interviewed an abortion counselor, an Icelandic scientist, and the mothers of children with Down syndrome.

She also interviewed an Icelandic woman who has Down syndrome.

People "just see Downs. They don't see me," she told Quijano. "It doesn't feel good. I want people to see that I am just like everybody else." In 2009, only three babies with Down syndrome were born in Iceland. Only one mom in the entire country has two children with Down syndrome. She lives in Hellissandur, on the northern coast. "Yes, of course" some women express guilt at aborting their disabled babies, the abortion counselor told Quijano. The pro-abortion counselor showed her a prayer card with the footprints of an aborted baby. Parents can keep these footprints and prayer cards as a memento of their aborted child.

She said she tells women, "This is your life. You have the right to choose how your life will look like."

"We don't look at abortion as murder," she continued. "We look at it as a thing that we ended. We ended a possible life that may have had huge complications." It is "preventing suffering for the child and also the family."

"The media sell this little three-year-old, nice cute one," the abortion counselor continued. "But you have to look at Down syndrome as a spectrum. You have this little cute one who was Down syndrome ... and then we have people who [have] Down syndrome plus lots of other complication[s]."

She said she sees life's moral decisions as "gray" rather than "black and white."

The Icelandic mother of a young child with Down syndrome asked Quijano, "What kind of society do you want to live in?"

One expectant mom told Quijano she decided to forgo the test because "it wouldn't make a difference, actually." She said she works with autistic children and has a brother-in-law who has Down syndrome. "I think it's just horrible, the statistics."

The CBS report pointed out that the country's socialized healthcare system requires doctors to tell women about the option of prenatal testing for genetic defects.

There is "some truth" to the notion that informing women of this steers them toward abortion, a technician who does the prenatal tests said. "Obviously, if you didn't mention it, then you wouldn't be thinking about it."

"My heart breaks for the innocent babies aborted in Iceland because society has deemed certain people undeserving of life," Kristan Hawkins, president of Students for Life of America, told LifeSiteNews. "My children with genetic disabilities are loved and valued the same as my children without. I pray this report will wake up the people of Iceland to the discriminatory killing occurring amongst them. I pray they wake up before even more human beings fall victim to this disgusting mindset."

For when you offer your gifts and</u> <u>make your sons pass through the fire, you defile yourselves with all your idols, even to this</u> <u>day. So shall I be inquired of by you, O house of Israel? As I live," says the Lord God, "I</u> <u>will not be inquired of by you. What you have in your mind shall never be, when you say,</u> <u>'We will be like the Gentiles, like the families in other countries, serving wood and stone.</u>"

May we not follow after the things of the world, but may we follow after God!
